

Ironhorse Rail Camp

This camp is a unique opportunity to personally experience living history by learning to operate period railroad equipment in an environment that focuses on crew integration, interpretation of railroad activities, and safety.

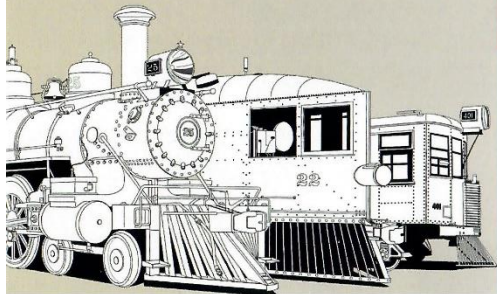
The camp has limited availability in order to ensure that adequate time is allotted to each facet of instruction and activity.

Participants will operate a steam locomotive, Virginia & Truckee #25, and two vintage motorcars, Virginia & Truckee #22 McKeen car and the #401 Edwards Car.

In addition to the hands-on operation of equipment, participants will learn other crew duties such as conductor and brakeman. Individuals will prepare the equipment for the day's activity and conduct the maintenance required for operations. You will get dirty. Individuals need to be able to climb, work in confined areas and be able to lift and carry at least 25lbs over uneven ground.

Included in the camp tuition is a one-year membership to the Friends of the Nevada State Railroad Museum, gloves, engineer's cap, all materials and handouts, breakfast and lunch, and dinner on Saturday evening.

Get your application in early to ensure your spot.

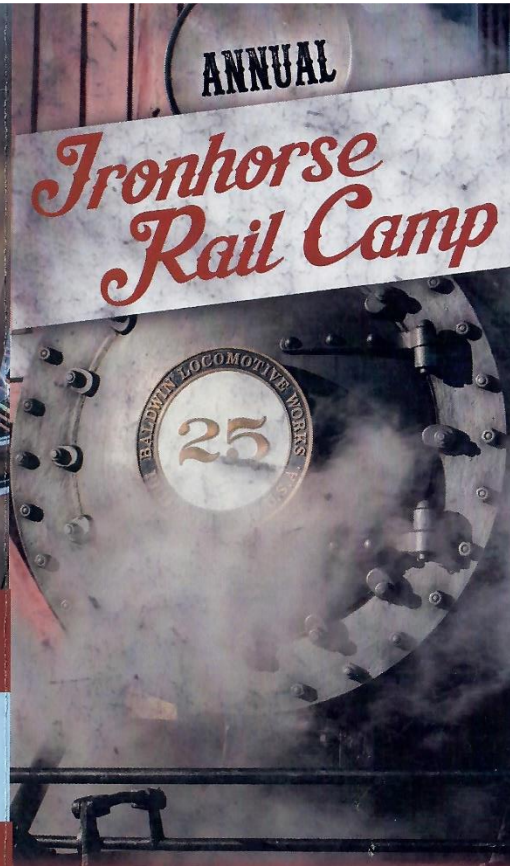


Cancellation Policy

If you need to cancel your reservation you will receive a full refund if you cancel before May 15 or a 50% refund after May 15.

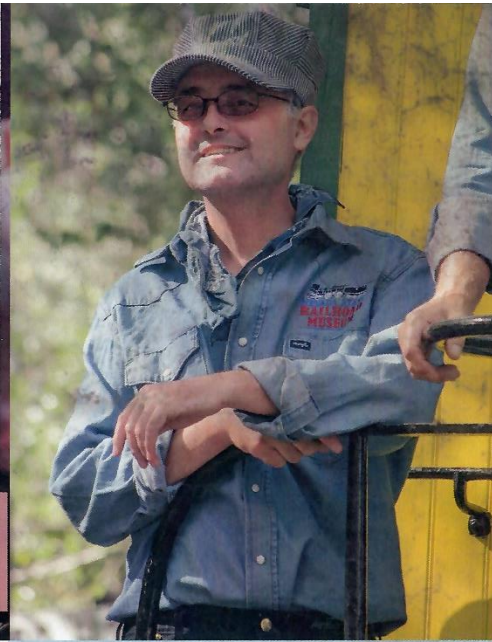

The Nevada State Railroad Museum is a cultural resource dedicated to educating visitors and the community about Nevada railroad history. This mission is accomplished through the collection, preservation and interpretation of significant locomotives, rolling stock, artifacts, photographs and memorabilia directly related to railroads and railroading in Nevada. In addition to static exhibits, select pieces of equipment in the collection are restored and operated throughout the year to demonstrate steam and early internal combustion technology and provide visitors with a first-hand experience with railroad history through the sights, sounds and sensations of a train ride.
