Santa Train runs every half-hour from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

FAQs

Where do the train rides at the museum go?

Trains leave from the Wabuska depot (at the main entrance to the museum property) and ride a radial loop around the museum grounds. Train rides are approximately 40 minutes long.

Where do I catch the train to Virginia City?

NOT at the Nevada State Railroad Museum. The train from Carson City to Virginia City is operated by the Virginia & Truckee Railway.
