

MINUTES OF THE APRIL 2, 2018  
BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING  
NEVADA STATE RAILROAD MUSEUM  
CARSON CITY, NEVADA

**Call to order** - Meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM

**Role Call** – Trustees present were Howie Foster, Rick Kohler, Barry Simcoe, Rebecca Bevans, Michael McClain, Amanda Thompson and John Baumgardner. Representing the museum was Adam Michalski. Bill Kohler and Larry Knack were excused absences. A quorum was established.

Minutes of the February 5, 2017 regular meeting was approved. Motion to approve made by Howie Foster, second by Michael McClain.

**Correspondence** – None

**Treasurer's report** – Larry Knack submitted reports for the period of January 1, 2018 thru February 28, 2018. Motion made by Rebecca Bevans, second by Rick Kohler. Motion passed.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

### **-Capital Campaign Committee-**

Barry Simcoe reported that the Campaign is on temporary hold.

### **-Bricks –**

Howie Foster reported that there has been one brick sale since the last report. There are approximately 30 bricks in process. Howie reported that the engraving vendor has relocated from Reno to Fallon. Effort will be made to identify a back-up engraver in case the existing company ceases to provide engraving services. There is no indication that they will at this point.

There was discussion around establishing an engraving standard for active volunteers that pass away in lieu of the family providing their own verbiage. It was determined that the standard will include the following information: Volunteer Name, “Loyal Volunteer, NSRM” and DOB-DOD. A motion was made by Rebecca Bevans with a second by Michael McClain with unanimous approval for this.

Also, a list of active volunteers that have passed within the past five years was requested of the museum staff in an effort to assure each receives a brick in their memory.

### **-Events Committee –**

Rebecca Bevans presented a summary of upcoming events scheduled for the upcoming 2018 operating season. (Attached)

Barry Simcoe emphasized that any planned events be brought to the event committee for support, discussion and approval.

Rebecca is working on brief job descriptions for event roles in an effort to attract future participants.

Given the success of the Easter weekend activities, it was encouraged that this event be added to future event schedules as volunteer resources would be greatly appreciated.

### **-Election Committee-**

Barry Simcoe posed a question about the feasibility of including an insert with annual membership renewals that asks members if they “are interested in serving on the board”.

Additionally, a motion was made by Howie Foster and seconded by Rebecca Bevans with unanimous approval to reinstate the mailing of board candidate voting post cards.

## **Steam Camp –**

There was a brief discussion around the possibility of establishing a waiting list for overflow applicants and around possibly taking deposits for the 2019 camp to assure an applicant's spot. Further discussion around these topics to continue during the upcoming Rail Camp meeting on April 9<sup>th</sup>.

Loren Jahn reported that the mortar has been painted. He recommended adding a border around the base of the flatcar which can include being lettered Nevada State Railroad Museum for better promotion. He also recommended placing the car on rail instead of sitting on the ground.

Loren indicated that the next scheduled project to be painted is the Julia car in anticipation of the 150<sup>th</sup> V&T celebration in 2019. It is hoped that some of this project can be showcased during the upcoming Arts and Culture day.

The front room of the Nelson House is still moving forward (in early stages) as an interpretation of a superintendent home.

Loren will take the lead in making sure that Handcar receives new paint ahead of it being used in the Nevada Day Parade in October.

It was discussed that the roof of the 57 car needs completing.
