FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHERE DO THE TRAIN RIDES AT THE MUSEUM GO?

Trains leave from the Wabuska depot (at the main entrance to the museum property) and ride a radial loop around the museum grounds. Train rides are approximately 40 minutes long.

WHERE DO I CATCH THE TRAIN TO VIRGINIA CITY?

NOT at the Nevada State
Railroad Museum. The train
from Carson City to Virginia City
is operated by the Virginia &
Truckee Railway. Trains depart
from their Eastgate depot five
miles east of Carson City on
